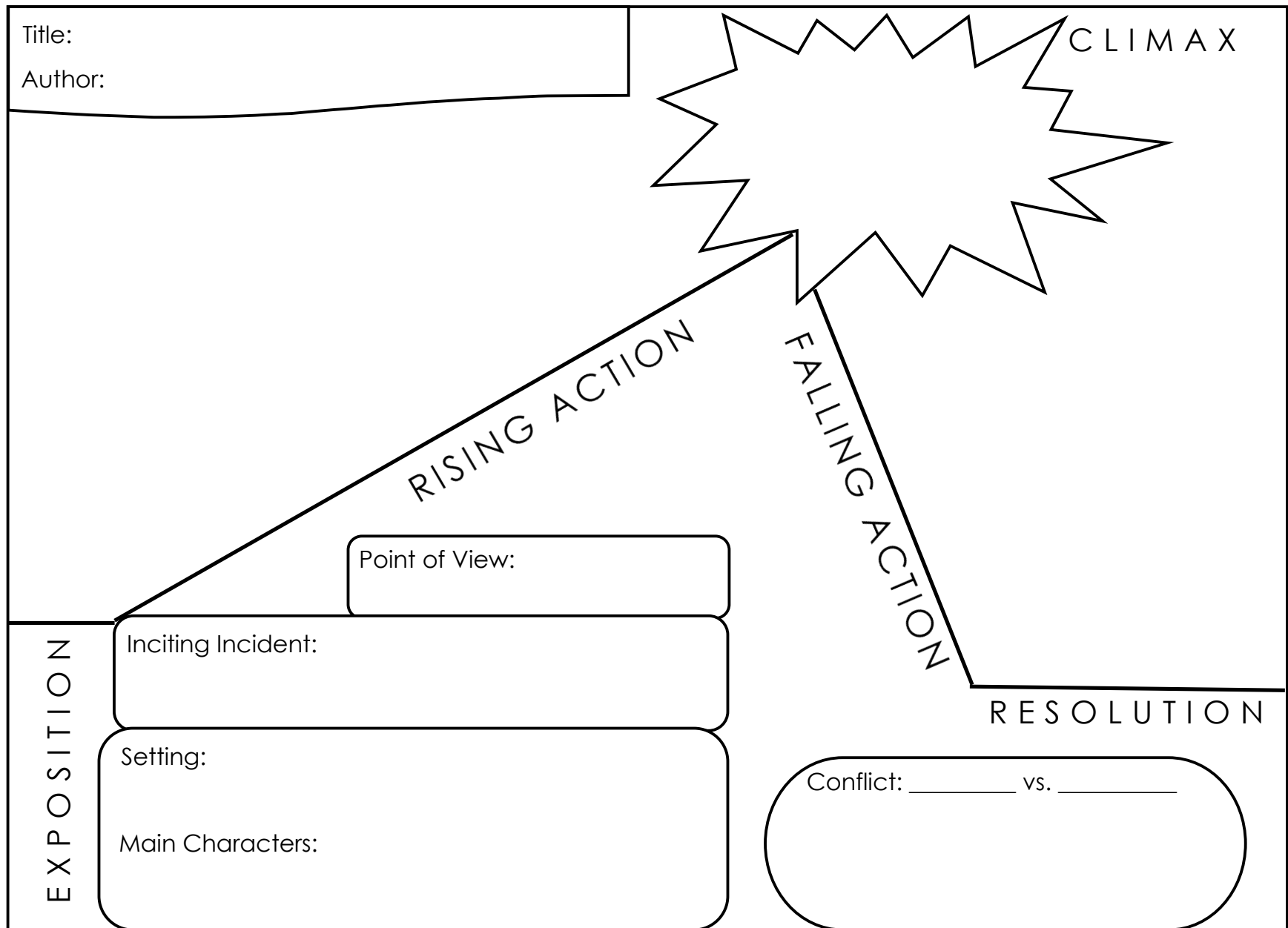



Plot Diagram Template


Plot Elements Foldables




Includes:
 Plot Structure Pyramid Foldables (blank and labeled)
 6-Tab Elements Foldables (blank and labeled)

Elements: Exposition, Inciting Incident, Rising Action, Climax, Falling Action, Resolution
 *All activities include a version with Inciting Incident and a version without Inciting Incident!

Plot Notes for Writing Inside Foldables

Element	Symbol	Notes
Exposition	—	• the first part of the plot • characters, setting, and basic situation are established
Inciting Incident	—	• the event that sets the story in motion • marks the end of the story's setup
Rising Action	↗	• most part of the story • moves the plot along • where conflict
Climax	∧	• the most exciting part of the plot • the OMG • usually a turning point
Falling Action	↘	• events that lead to the resolution • conflicts begin resolution
Resolution	—	• the end of the story • loose ends of the story are tied up • conflicts are resolved

Directions for Pyramid Foldable

1. Cut out foldable along the perimeter on the outside back.
2. Fold along the dashed lines.
3. Cut along the black borders between elements, stopping at the dashed fold line.
4. Write in an 8-10 word definition for each element. You can write for each element a CD or plot element.

*The definitions and characteristics for each plot element can be found in the notes chart on page 10 of this document.

Directions for Tab Foldables

1. Cut out foldable along the perimeter on the outside back.
2. Fold the left vertical tab and the right vertical tab on the right. On the back of this vertical tab is the only place you will put glue.
3. Glue the foldable into a notebook by putting glue tabs on the back of the notebook or into the notebook if you prefer.
4. Cut along the black borders between elements on the left and right tabs to glue down your tabs.
